1 Corinthians 12:12-31
Vs. 16-18 16 Do you not know that whoever is united to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For it is said, "The two shall be one flesh." 17 But anyone united to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. 18 Shun sexual immorality! Every sin that a person commit is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against the body itself.
Who and what we give your attention to determines our
Flesh:
 The physical body or human nature (e.g., John 1:14, "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us"). Human nature in its frailty and susceptibility to sin (e.g., Romans 7:18, "I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my flesh"). The sinful nature or the aspect of humanity that is opposed to the Spirit (e.g., Galatians 5:17, "For the flesh craves what is contrary to the Spirit").
Shun/ Flee:

Avoid giving any attention to anything that threatens to rob you of your anointing!
