1 Corinthians 6:12-20 (NRSV) – Glorify God in Body and Spirit

Glorify God in all things!

Vs. 12,13 **12** “All things are permitted for me,” but not all things are beneficial. “All things are permitted for me,” but I will not be dominated by anything.

13 “Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food,” and God will destroy both one and the other. The body is meant not for sexual immorality but for the Lord and the Lord for the body.

1 Corinthians 12:12-31

Vs. 16-18 **16** Do you not know that whoever is united to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For it is said, “The two shall be one flesh.” **17** But anyone united to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. **18** Shun sexual immorality! Every sin that a person commit is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against the body itself.

Flesh: _____

- The physical body or human nature (e.g., ***John 1:14, "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us"***).
- Human nature in its frailty and susceptibility to sin (e.g., **Romans 7:18, "I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my flesh"**).
- The sinful nature or the aspect of humanity that is opposed to the Spirit (e.g., **Galatians 5:17, "For the flesh craves what is contrary to the Spirit"**).

Shun/ Flee: _____

Avoid giving any attention to anything that threatens to rob you of your anointing!

Vs. 19,20 **19** Or do you not know that your body is a temple[g] of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God, and that you are not your own? **20** For you were bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body.
